

ACUTE 19 ASYMPTOMATIC Testing Workflow-IN OFFICE

Patient is present in office for a non covid related matter, and requests a COVID test.

Provider inquires about COVID related symptoms or possible contacts/exposure. Provider asks about patient's occupation.

If patient is asymptomatic, **testing is warranted if:**
Patient has possible exposure;
Patient is essential worker;
Patient is over the age of 60;
Patient has an underlying condition.
All other patients are at the provider's discretion.

PROVIDER orders SARS-CoV-2 PCR testing.

ROOMER prints label, requisition form. Puts label, req form, FHN ASYMPTOMATIC instructions and covid swab and portable phone on a chux on the counter in the exam room.

PROVIDER will don PPE: n95 mask, surgical mask over n95, face shield, gown, gloves.

MA/LPN sets up drape on floor outside of the room, stands by.

COVID19 test performed

PROVIDER labels swab in the room, writes "NP" on label for COVID19, gives patient FHN ASYMPTOMATIC instructions, opens door and drops specimen into its own specimen bag held open by MA/LPN.

PROVIDER will doff PPE EXCEPT for n95 mask outside of room on drape set up by MA/LPN on the floor. PPE gathered by MA/LPN are placed in a biohazard bag. Provider instructs patient to leave through the normal exit/check out area.

PROVIDER will notify CLINIC MANAGER that COVID19 specimen was collected. CLINIC MANAGER will complete the COVID test log and send to Jess Manderville for reporting/tracking.

MA/LPN will prepare COVID19 specimen according to lab specifications.

MA/LPN labels room as unusable for 1 hour.

MA/LPN dons gloves and surgical mask and cleans room and phone after patient has been gone for 60 minutes, labels room unavailable for 30 minutes.
